

Audit report main remarks 03.02.23:

Social relations

Maintained effort: During today's inspection, the staff are observed to be engaged and interested in their work with the children. There is a nice atmosphere in the institution and it seems that the staff are aware of the children's signals and needs. The inspection experiences an environment where the children immediately find it easy to come into contact with the adults and get the necessary help, support and care. Likewise, adults are also seen who continuously initiate communication with the children. There is a fine division among the different groups, which contributes to a clear environment for the children. This practice can be continued.

Maintained effort: The inspection sees some different children's groups and activities during today's visit. There are many different play options in the institution and the interior has been divided, enough to create calm and clarity. The staff seem busy with their educational work and are seen as active and lively. In the situation with the child who was running around and was not calm enough to be able to join in at snack time in the cloakroom, the adult contacted the child with a smile and a calm voice. When PL finally ends up taking the child to another room (away from the children's group), the child seems happy and gets his exercise book with him. The supervisor subsequently spoke to PL and got an explanation as to why such actions were taken, which made perfect sense in relation to this particular child. Good games and activities were observed during today's visit and the children seemed happy and relaxed in each other's company. In the nursery, the adults had a good eye for which children needed a little extra communication and care. As previously mentioned, the inspection did not see any children who appeared to be alone or passive.

3. The efforts in language

Maintained effort: There are many visual impressions in the institution, materials, play equipment and things on the walls. The possibilities for division help to make all the impressions less overwhelming. In the nursery, the environment and furnishings are more toned down and manageable, which suits the needs of the age group well. The inspection find that the staff talk to the children in a nice and age-appropriate way. During today's visit, mainly Danish is spoken, but it is translated into English a few times, for the children who do not understand Danish yet. During the reading activity, the adult made a point of

speaking clearly, being actively engaged in the story and making room for the children's initiatives and stories. The division with small nooks around the institution helps to create calm for the children and the opportunity for immersion in various activities. The language environment is observed as having good conditions.

Overall assessment and follow-up:

In this report, three maintenance efforts are given.

The status is given based on the snapshot the inspectorate experienced during today's visit.

There was a good atmosphere, the children seemed active and bold in their movement around the institution. The staff were welcoming and made themselves available to the children.

PL talked about an everyday life in the institution which works well and where many different educational activities take place and where the staff focus on the children's development and which activities they can develop in the best possible way.
